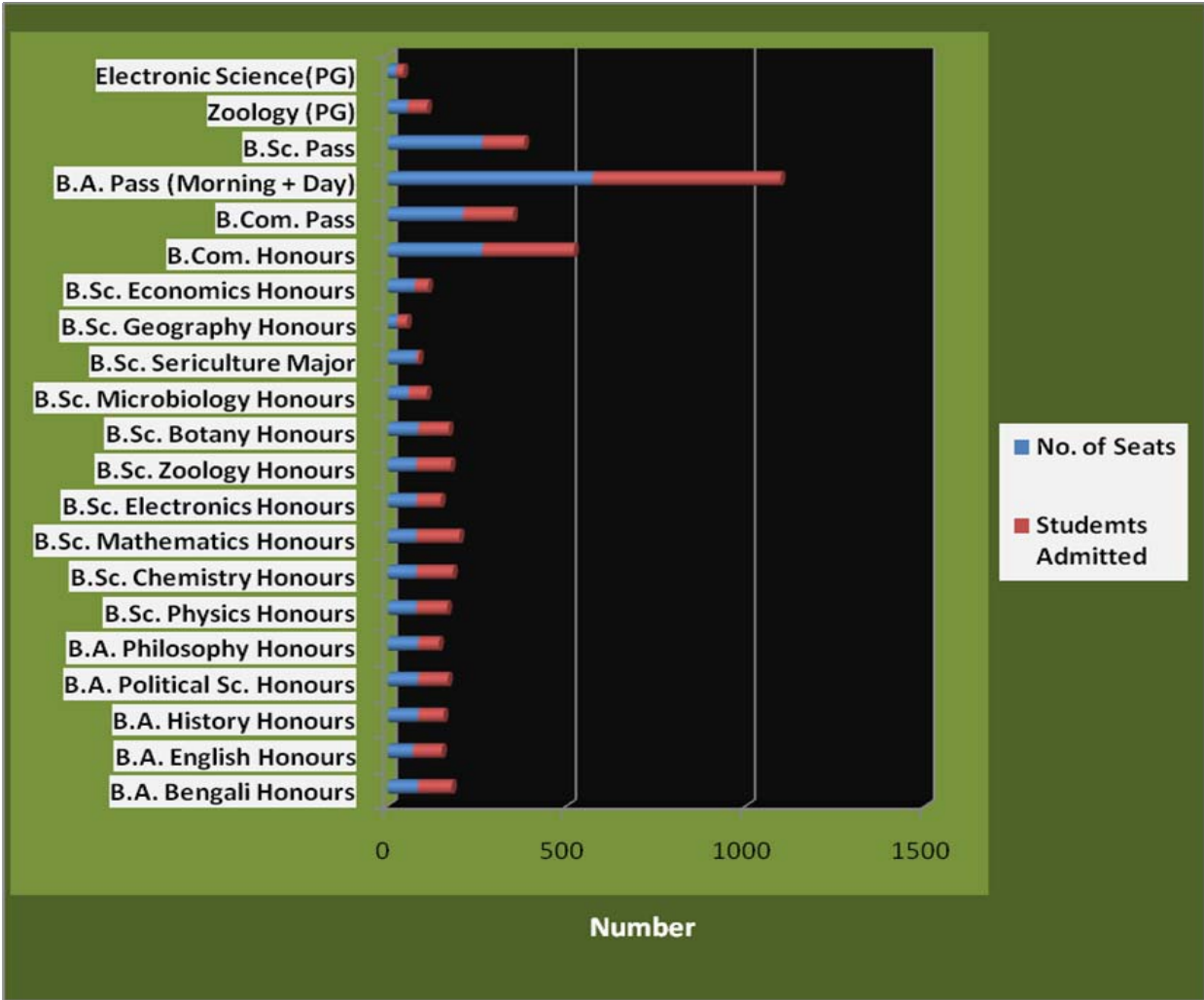

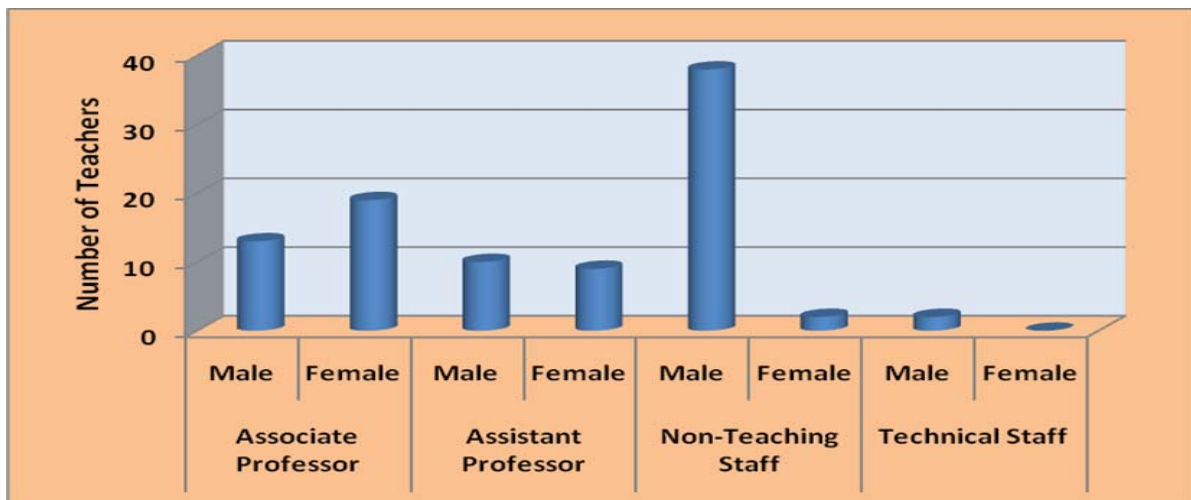

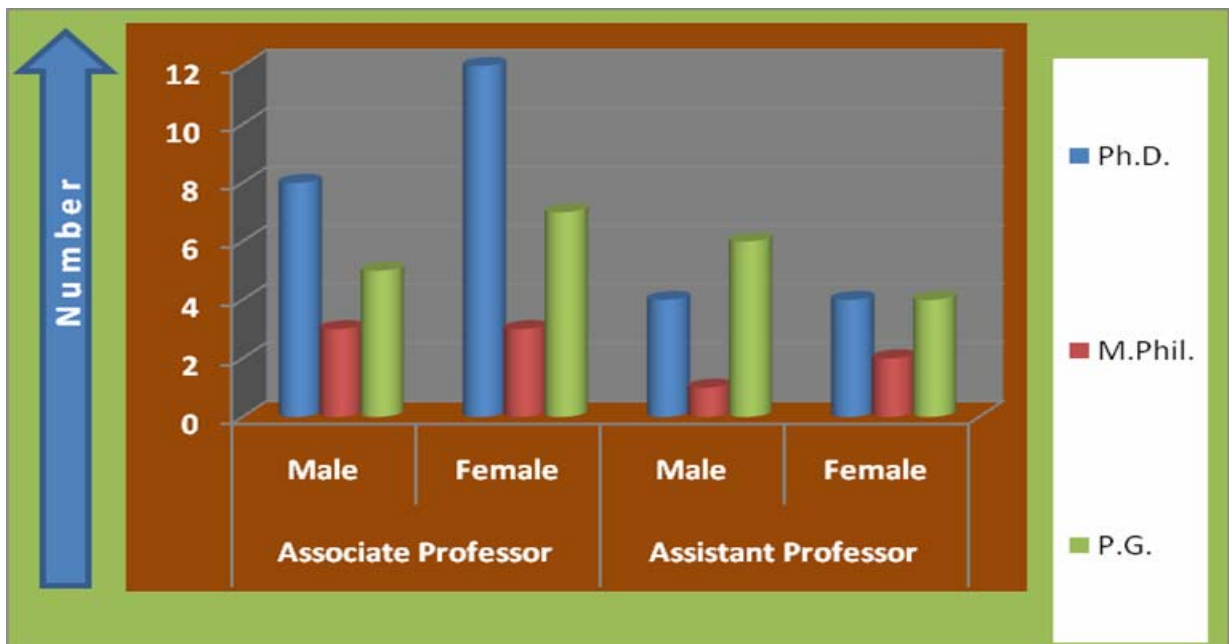


**Bar Diagram showing number of teaching and non teaching staff in position**

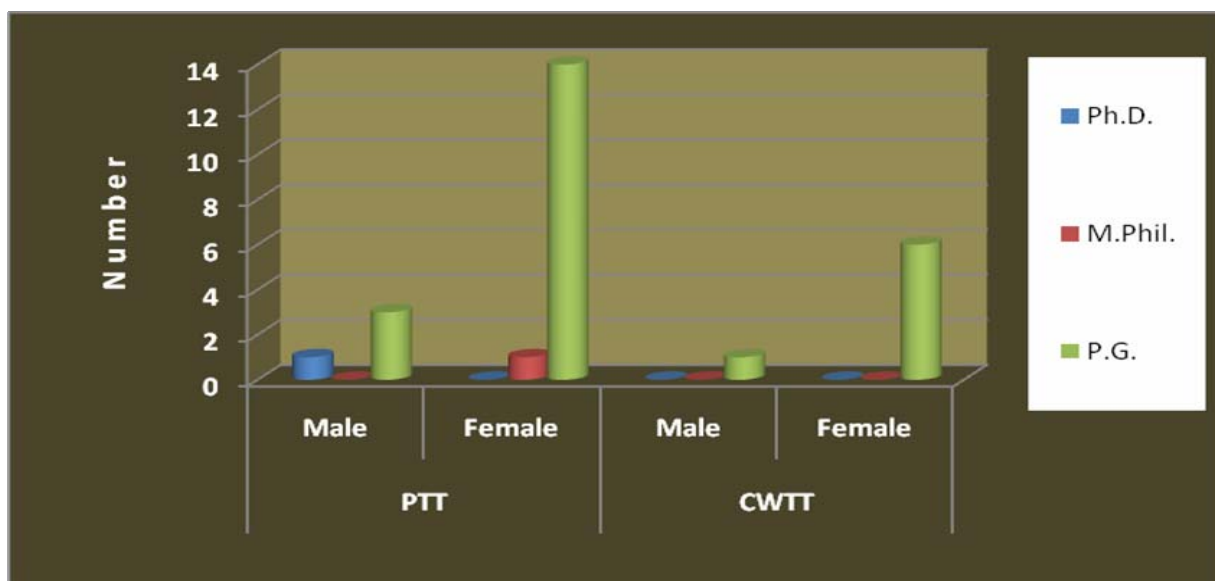

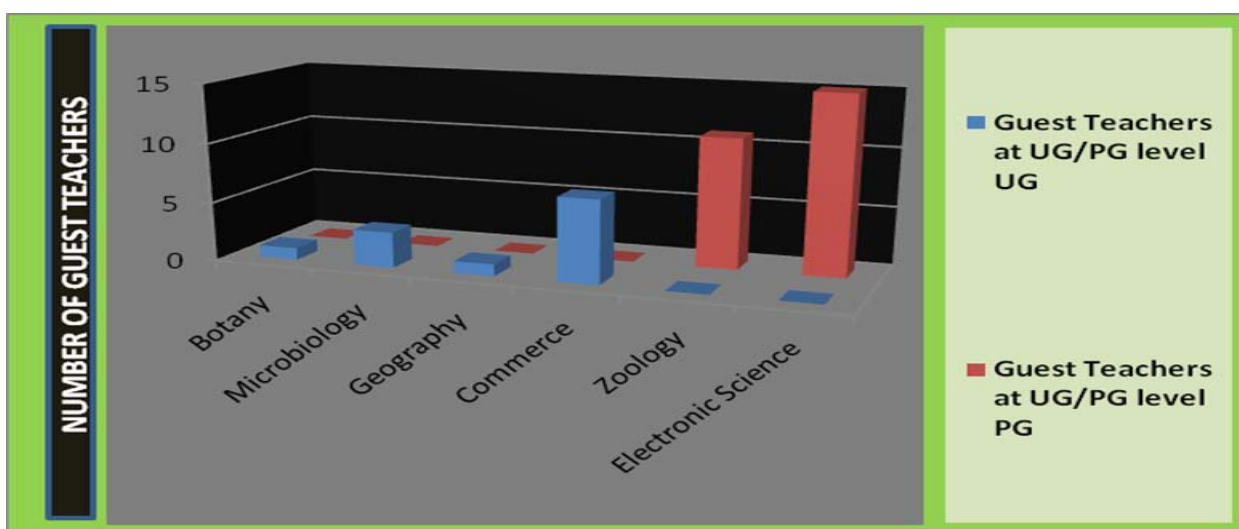
**Quality of teachers: Associate Professor & Assistant Professor**

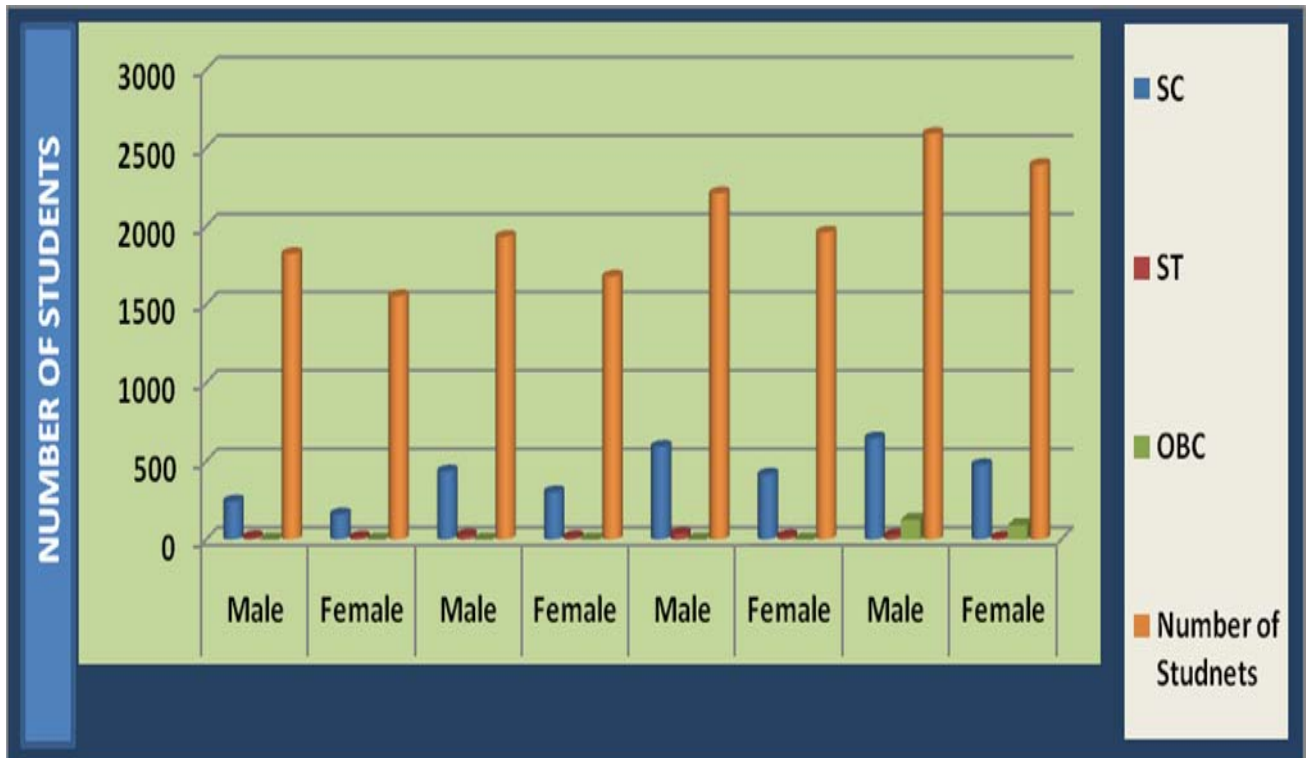

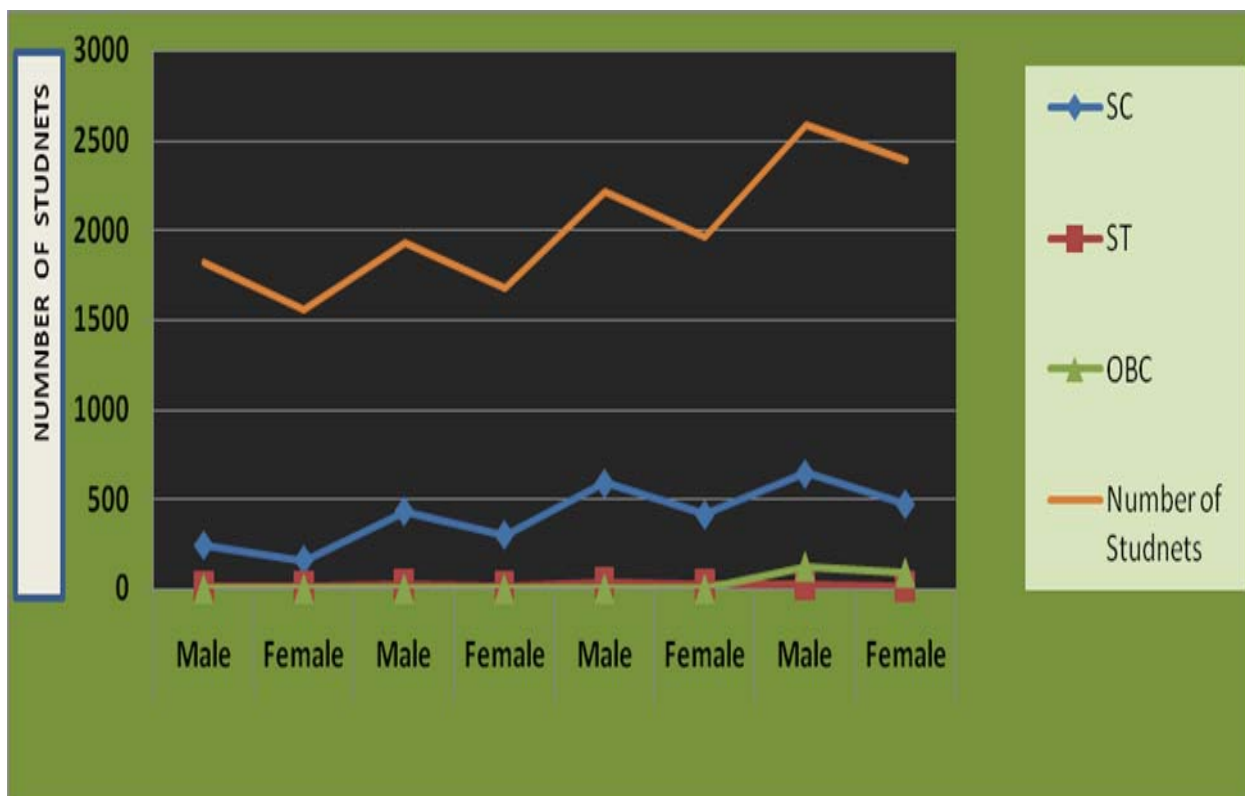
**Bar Diagram shows the number of Guest Teachers in different Departments (UG + PG)**

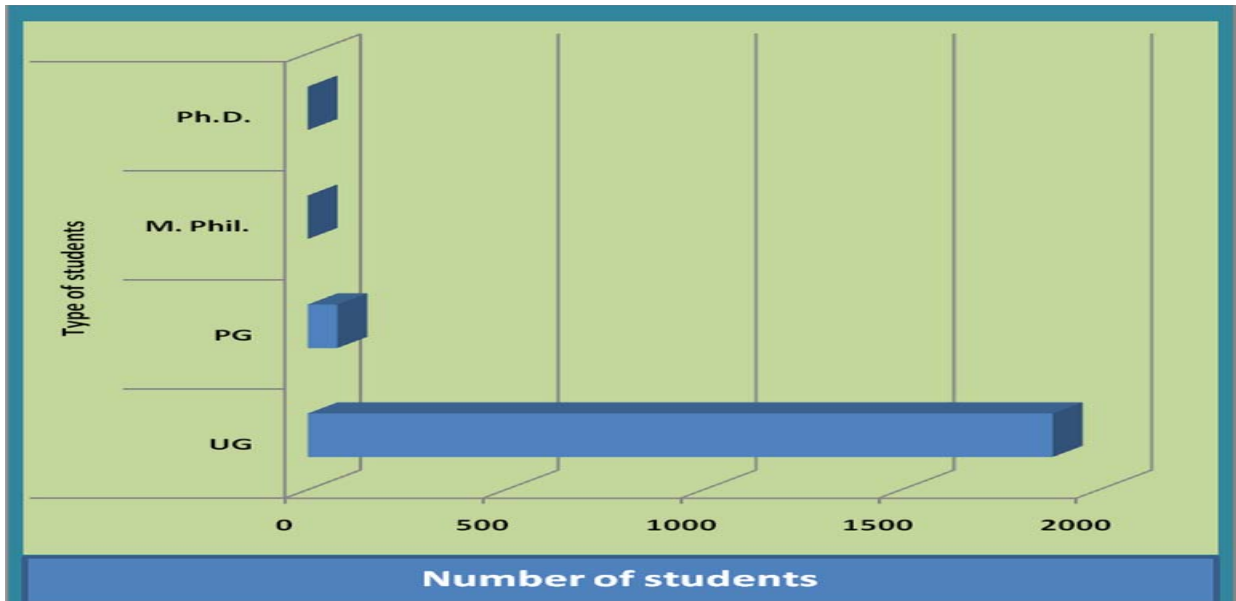
Year wise and category wise number of students admitted in last 4 years

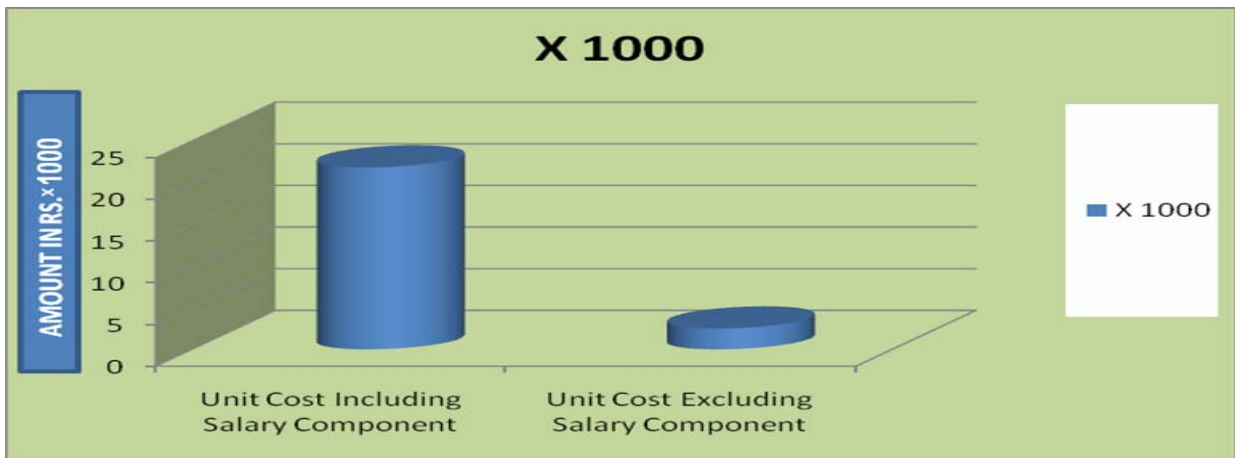
**Bar Diagram shows the number of undergraduate and postgraduate students admitted in the current academic year (all the students admitted were from the state of West Bengal)**

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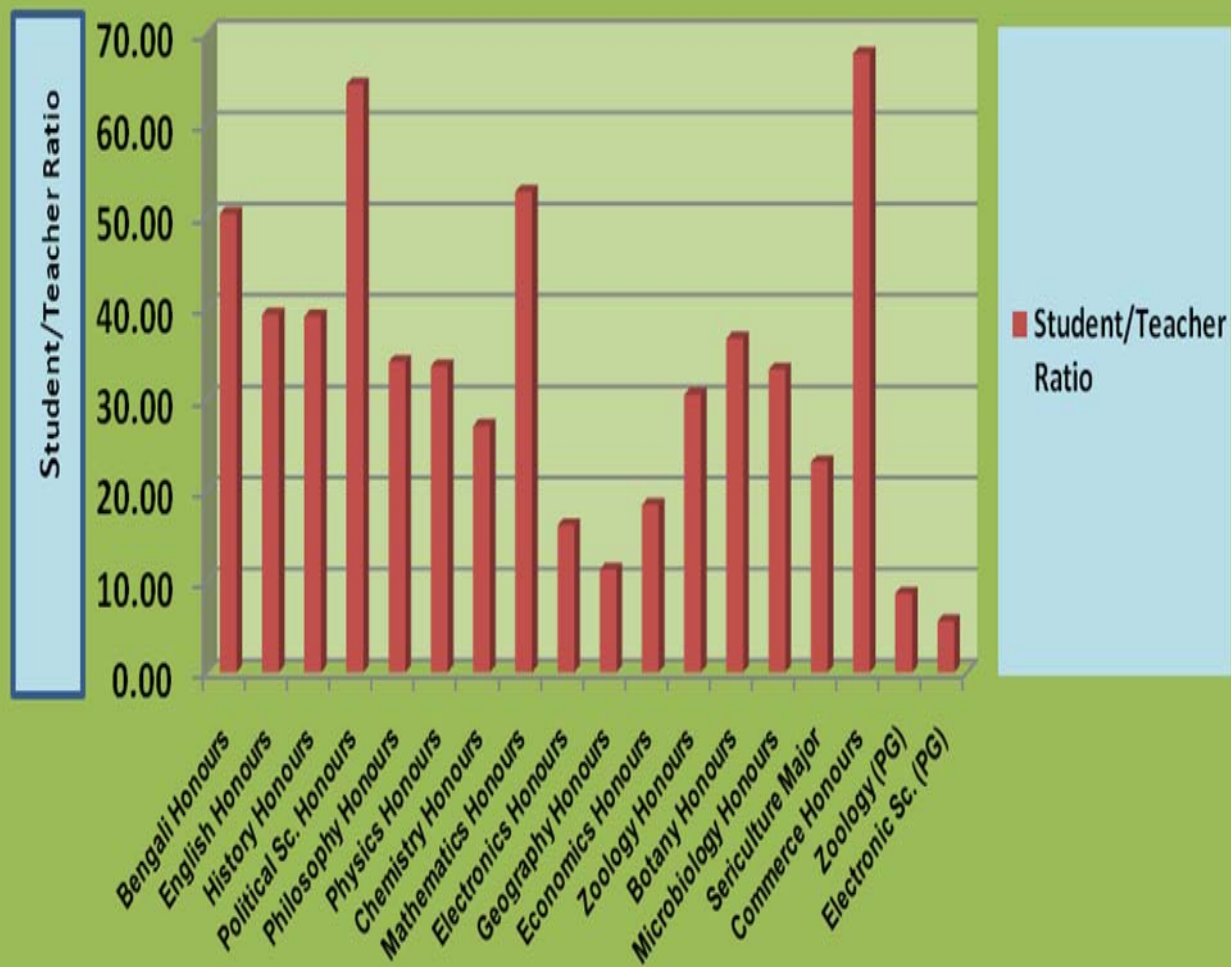
