ADMISSION NOTIFICATION NO. 2/2022, DATED 06.07.2022 ADMISSION TO UNDERGRADUATE COURSES, 2022-2023

In accordance with the Govt. Order No. [507-Edn\(CS\)/10M-95/14 dated 30.06.2022](#), it is notified for the general information of all concerned that the Admission Process for admission to the undergraduate (B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com., Honours/Major/General) courses, 2022-23 (Semester System) **will commence on 18th July, 2022**. Those who seek admission must apply ONLINE through the college website: <https://www.dacollege.org> between **18.07.2022 (00.01 AM) and 05.08.2022 (11.59 PM)**. **There shall be no scope for submission of Applications through offline mode.**

The complete merit-based list of valid applicants and 1st Admission list will be published on the college website on **16th August, 2022 after 06-30 p.m.** The applicants enlisted for admission (1st Admission List, 2nd Admission List, and so on, subject to the availability of seats) will be allowed to pay admission fees online from **17th August, 2022** onwards [specific date and time of payment of admission fees will be mentioned in the respective admission list(s)].

The students shall be enlisted in the Complete Merit List as well as in the Admission Lists (Academic Session 2022- 23) subject to the fulfillment of the conditions as laid down in the Calcutta University Notification No. CSR/03/18 dated 07.5.2018 for B.A./B.Sc. (Honours/General), CSR/26/17 dated 26.5.2017 for B.Sc.(Major) and CSR/64/17 dated 14.9.2017 & CSR/10/18 dated 30.5.2018 for B.Com. (Honours/General).

Those who have passed 10+2 examination or its equivalent examination in 2017 and onwards (i.e., in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022) are eligible to seek admission to 1st Semester B.A./B.Sc./B.Com [General (Pass)/ Honours (Advance)/Major] courses provided that he/she has also passed in English having full marks not less than 100 and fulfill the conditions as mentioned in the above referred CU Notifications.

Candidates already registered with CU in 2019 or earlier in a particular course and combination (CBCS) are not eligible for the same course and combination vide CSR/03/18, dt.07.05.2018.

Criteria for application

1.For General (Pass) Courses

Passed 10+2 level examination of recognized Board/Council AND also passed in English having full marks not less than 100

2.For Honours (Advance) Courses

2.1. For candidates belonging to General (Un-reserved) Category

- Passed in English having full marks not less than 100
AND
- Obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (average marks of best four subjects excluding Environmental Studies/Education if it is compulsory subject) AND at least 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the 10+ 2 level
OR
- Obtained at least 55% marks in the subject or related subject
OR
- Obtained 50% marks in aggregate (average marks of best four subjects excluding Environmental Studies/Education if it is a compulsory subject) in case the candidate HAS NOT studied the subject in his/her previous qualifying examination (10+2level Exam) provided all other criteria are fulfilled

2.2. For candidates belonging to Reserved Categories **

- Passed in English having full marks not less than 100
AND
- Obtained at least 40% marks in aggregate (average marks of best four subjects excluding Environmental Studies/Education if it is a compulsory subject)
- at least 40% marks in the subject or related subject at the 10+ 2 level

N.B. If the subject 'Environmental Science' is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it can be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.
